### MEMORY LANE:

#### **Psalm 23 ~ The Lord is my Shepherd**

10<sup>th</sup>- 16<sup>th</sup> October: Ps 23:4

Let us revise and **memorise all of Ps 23:1-4 this week**

Notice the **change of pronoun:** In verses 1-3 it is: The Lord... He... Now in v4 it becomes: You are with **me**... Your God, etc. The trekking with the sheep inevitably leads through valleys and canyons – but the Shepherd’s presence is the greatest of comforts for the sheep – His rod was used against predators, and His staff was helpful in restoring sheep that strayed too near precipices. (See Isa. 41:10)

“...fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.”
