



**MISSIONS FOCUS**  
**CHARLES & JULIE WOODROW**  
**GRACE TO MOZAMBIQUE**

Summary based on July 2024 Newsletter

Dr. Charles Woodrow provides an update on his ministry in Nampula, Mozambique, highlighting key developments and urgent needs. The foremost concern is the upcoming 2024 annual FIEL pastors conference, which has seen unprecedented registration numbers, far exceeding available resources. The conference, focused on deepening the understanding of salvation by grace through faith, is a critical event for the Evangelical church in Mozambique. Despite financial and logistical challenges, including the need for additional accommodations and transport, the ministry is committed to hosting the event.

Dr. Woodrow also reports on the literature distribution ministry, which supports over 262 church leaders across Mozambique, with more leaders eager to join. Additionally, the ministry faced a significant setback when a proposal crucial for their medical-evangelistic work was initially rejected but later approved after persistent efforts.

On a personal note, Dr. Woodrow shares health updates about himself and his wife, both recovering from major surgeries, and joyful news about their expanding family, including their children's achievements and the arrival of grandchildren.

The ministry also encountered a house fire, which, though dramatic, was contained, leaving the house in need of significant repairs. Despite these challenges, the ministry continues to grow, with three new administrators hired to support its expanding activities.

The newsletter ends with a testimony of God's provision. After fervent prayers for financial guidance, the ministry received nearly \$21,000 in unexpected donations, affirming their path. However, they still face a \$15,000 shortfall for the conference and seek continued prayers and support

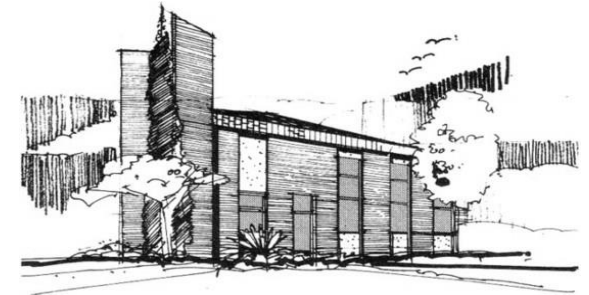

## MEMORY LANE:

### THE PLAN OF SALVATION

**1<sup>st</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> September: Romans 10:9-10**

As intentional memorizers we select key Scripture passages and *inscribe* them on the walls of our brains. The phrase “*Jesus is Lord*” was a N.T. confession of faith. Here by we *acknowledge* that we make Him the *Lord of our Lives*

#### Practical tips to Help You Memorize Scripture:

1. Memorize the Word of God in *community*, i.e. with a church member or in a Bible study: This is one way to live out Proverbs 27:17, “As iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another.”
2. Memorize along *with your family*.  
This is a great way to teach the whole family Scripture.
3. Place *note cards* all over the house.
4. Listen to an *audio Bible*.
5. Pray for *God to help* you. Psalm 119:33
6. Find *Software* to help. There is an App for that! Try MemVerse, RememberMe or MobilizeFaith.
- 7 Put it to *song*.
8. *Read* out loud/*write* it out. This is the reliable old-fashioned method and it is two learning styles as well: visual and tactile.
