#### PRAY FOR DISPLACED PEOPLES IN NORTH AFRICA

North Africa is a transit route for desperate migrants fleeing famine, poverty, war, and militant violence. They are arriving by the tens of thousands, displaced people from sub-Saharan Africa and beyond, often headed to Europe to find renewed hope. It's a courageous effort to survive. But where can they go? Locals don't want them and they are penniless. They are vulnerable to violent gangs who randomly kill and enslave them. Amazingly, every one of these millions of displaced people are seen and loved by Jesus. He is intimately acquainted with despair. They are offered the riches of His grace and the security of a home in Him. He is their HOPE.

#### PRAY FOR DISPLACED PEOPLES IN SAHEL

The Sahel is a massive area stretching across Africa between the Sahara Desert to the north and the savannas to the south. Millions across the Sahel have fled for their lives — many with nothing but the clothes on their backs. The fortunate ones will make it to relatives' homes or even a refugee camp. But many don't make it. \*Audu is a former Muslim who now follows Jesus. He is also a displaced person in the Sahel. Cry out for God's mercy and provision for these millions who suffer — each one knit together by God Himself and created in His image. Only He can save.

#### PRAY FOR DISPLACED PEOPLES IN EAST AFRICA

Some of the world's largest refugee camps are in East Africa— holding more than one million people. Tribal war and Islamist violence force these people to flee their homes and villages. The oppression they face is severe. They find themselves homeless and helpless. Unwanted and lost. Traumatized, anxious, and fearful. No one wants to remain in the camps. Everyone talks and dreams about returning home or migrating abroad. What if they learned that Jesus Christ is their home? They are wanted and found by Christ. He is their eternal HOPE and HOME!
