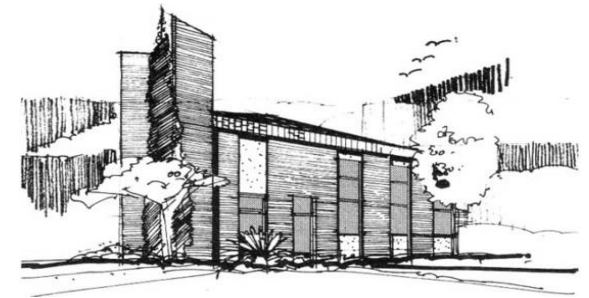

MEMORY LANE

THE “All’s” OF THE BIBLE – Isaiah 45:22

Look ye ALL and see the Jesus, the Saviour.

This text wrought one of the most famous conversions in history. Charles Spurgeon when he was fifteen was driven in a snowstorm to a Primitive Baptist church where a handful of worshippers. The pastor was snowed in. An old faithful man, without preparation started the sermon on Isa 45:22. Spurgeon recalled: “I owe my conversion to Christ to an unknown person, who certainly was no minister in the ordinary sense of the term; but who could say this much ---

“Look unto Christ and be saved, ALL ye ends of the earth.” KJV.
