- that churches would be able to care for one another with wisdom and generosity

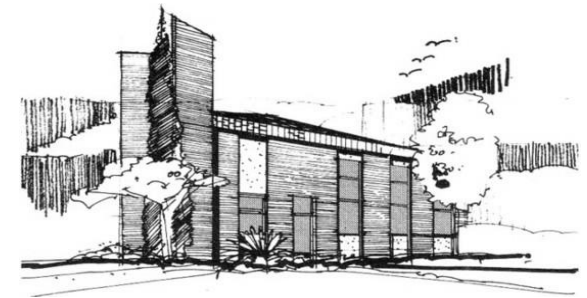

## BAPTIST CONFESSION OF FAITH OF 1689

**PROVIDENCE: Chapter 5 Paragraph 6**

The perfectly wise, righteous, and gracious God often leaves for a time [even] his own children to various temptations, and to the corruption of their own hearts. He does this to chastise them for their former sins, or to show them the hidden strength of the corruption and deceitfulness still in their hearts so that they may be humbled, and to bring them to a closer and more constant dependence on him for their support, and to make them more watchful against future occasions of sin, and for various other just and holy ends.<sup>1</sup> So whatever happens to any of his elect it is by his appointment, for his glory and for their good.<sup>2</sup>
