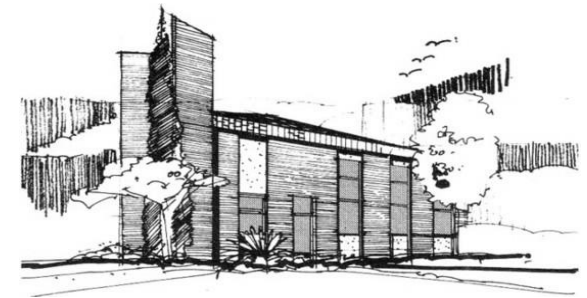

BAPTIST CONFESSION OF FAITH OF 1689 GOD’S COVENANT WITH THE HUMAN RACE Chapter 7 Paragraph 3

This covenant is revealed through the Gospel; first of all to Adam in the promise of salvation by the seed of the woman, and afterwards step by step until the full revelation of it was completed in the New Testament.¹ This salvation rests on that eternal covenant transaction between the Father and the Son which concerns the redemption of the elect.² It is by the grace of this covenant alone that all the descendants of fallen Adam who have ever been saved have obtained life and blessed immortality. Human beings are now utterly incapable of gaining acceptance with God.

THE “All’s” OF THE BIBLE – Philippians 4:4-5
Let your moderation be known to all (KJV)

Philippians 4:4-5 urges believers to be reasonable **to all people**, be patient, be kind, and be willing to yield rights rather than demanding them. This attitude reflects Christian maturity, prioritizing love and peace over personal vindication, especially in disagreements.

- **Reasonableness and Flexibility:** It is a deliberate choice to be lenient, patient, and considerate rather than rigid, stubborn, or argumentative.
- **Handling Conflict:** It involves responding to disagreements or mistreatment with grace and patience rather than retaliation or harshness.
- **"To All" Men:** This demeanor is not just for friends or fellow believers, but must be shown to everyone—even antagonists.
