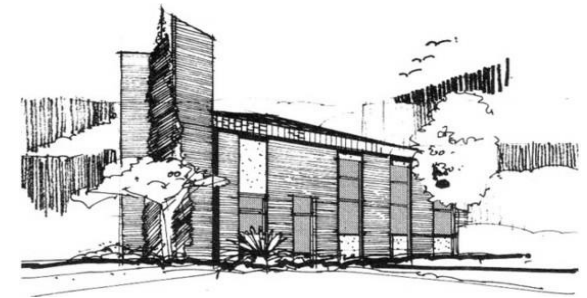

CHRIST THE MEDIATOR

Chapter 8 Paragraph 3

The Lord Jesus, his human nature thus united to the divine in the person of the Son, was sanctified and anointed with the Holy Spirit without limit, so in him are all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. It pleased the Father that all fullness should dwell in him, so that being holy, harmless, undefiled, and full of grace and truth, he might be perfectly qualified to execute the office of a mediator and surety.¹ He did not take this office upon himself, but was called to it by his Father, who also put all power and judgment in his hands, and commanded him to execute these.²

MEMORY LANE

THE "All's" OF THE BIBLE Proverbs 3:6

"Trust the Lord with every detail of your life."

Some Christians hold a view of God establishes certain parameters for our lives but doesn't involve Himself in the specifics, that He doesn't specifically know or ordain our steps. But **Reformed Christians believe God's guidance is detailed, daily, personal, unfailing and pre-planned**, as Psalm 139:19 says: ALL my days were written in your book and planned before a single one of them began."

If God has planned **all my days**, I should acknowledge Him in **all my ways**. That means developing the habit of **deliberately pausing to ask God's will** before making a purchase, giving an answer, making a decision or taking an action. **Acknowledge God as Lord of that matter.** "Lord give me wisdom and grant me favour!"
