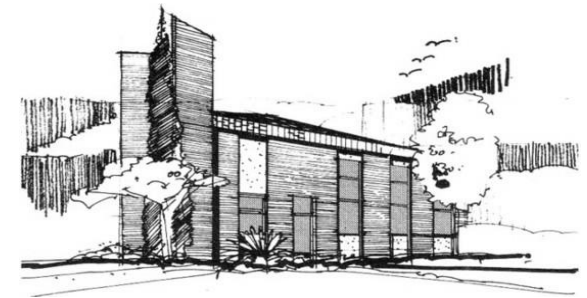

Although the price¹ of redemption was not actually paid² by Christ till after his incarnation, yet its value, efficacy, and benefits were communicated to the elect in all ages from the beginning of the world.³ This was accomplished through those promises, types, and sacrifices in which he was revealed and represented as the seed of the woman who should bruise the serpent's head,⁴ and the Lamb slain from the beginning of the world,⁵ for he is the same, yesterday and today and forever.⁶

THE “All’s” OF THE BIBLE

The Affirmations of Job - Job 1:22

“In all this Job did not sin or charge God with wrong.”

There are 290 questions in the forty-two chapters of the Book of Job and every chapter except Job 29 contains a question mark.

Job lost everything and the word *why* occurs twenty-eight times as Job struggled to make sense of his loss and pain. **Yet five times in this book Job affirmed his faith refusing to give in to despair.**

And it is because of these five declarations, that the Bible spoke later of Job as model of perseverance (James 5:11).

Next week we will be going through Job’s series of problems and Job’s conclusions about God in every instance in times of hardship.
