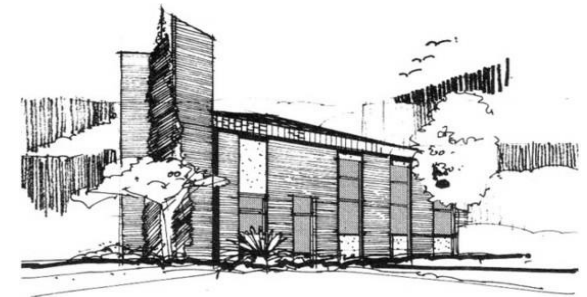

BAPTIST CONFESSION OF FAITH OF 1689 CHRIST THE MEDIATOR Chapter 8 Paragraph 4

The Lord Jesus undertook this office entirely willingly.¹ To discharge it he was subject to the law² and perfectly fulfilled it. He also underwent the punishment due to us which we should have borne and suffered.³ He was made sin and was accursed for us;⁴ he endured the extremities of agonizing distress in his soul and painful suffering in his body.⁵ He was crucified, and died,⁶ and remained in the state of the dead, yet his body did not decay.⁷ On the third day he rose from the dead with the same body in which he had suffered,⁸ with which he also ascended into heaven,⁹ where he sits at the right hand of his Father making intercession [for his people].¹⁰ At the end of the world he will return to judge human beings and angels.¹¹
