Hi friends,

We hope you're all well. Since our last update God has been working mightily in our area. Last year we reported 17 regular attendees to our house church and now we currently have around 25 regular members. Each life is truly valuable to God. We are running not only the Sunday service, but women's Bible study, men's breakfast, Sunday school, and prayer meetings. It is a blessing to see our brothers and sisters in Christ pursuing Him and we are excited to see yet more growth through the Lord.

In Saraguro, the cultural identity is deeply woven with local belief, especially a very warped view of the "Divine Child" and Mary, who have been combined with other entities like the Sun-god and Mother Earth. This difference leads to a huge push-back against the truth of God's word as it's considered secondary to deep traditions. Another deep struggle we face is the cultural prevalence of drunkenness and broken homes. This harmful background provides a heavy weight of the lostness in the area.

This brokenness, however, leads many to question their realities and to look for more. Please pray that this need leads people to search and that God will place His truth in their paths. Pray especially that the men will make a radical commitment to become men of God.

We appreciate all the prayers for our ministry and ask that you continue to pray for us as a family who tries to serve God in and out of the house.

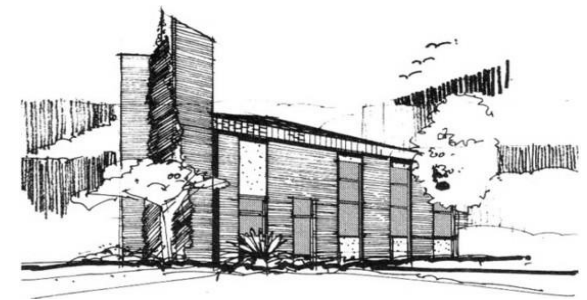

MEMORY LANE

THE “EDITIONS” OF THE DIVINE LAW –

Christians as Living Epistles ~ 2 Corinthians 3:2-3

Paul writes in these verses that the Corinthian church was a work of grace in which God has wonderfully used Paul and his coworkers with the Spirit of the Living God.

This “letter” that the Corinthians constituted was superior to the ink-only letters of Paul’s opponents because the **work of the Spirit in lives of the Corinthians was undeniably verifiable.**

The evident results in the Corinthians’ lives attested to the validity and superiority of tablets of human hearts **“known and read by everybody”** over that of tablets of stone, i.e. the Ten Commandments.

Observing Christians as living epistles means that the Church is intended to be the Word of God as a walking, breathing demonstration of God's grace.
